Dean of the Faculty of Psychology, University of Warsaw, invites applications for a position of

assistant professor in the field of animal psychology

(1 full research/teaching position)

Candidates are required to have:

- PhD in psychology or in a related field,
- published during the last four years at least two articles in journals with a high number of points according to the Polish Ministry publication index (an article published till 2018 at least 30 points according to the "old" Ministry list; an article published later at least 100 points according to the "new" Ministry list),
- documented research experience in the field of animal psychology,
- documented teaching experience in the field of animal psychology,
- documented international experience,
- fulfilled requirements listed in the par. 113 of the national higher education and science act, dated 20 July 2018 (Dz. U. poz. 1668 with amendments).

Additionally, a good candidate will have:

- experience in obtaining and conducting research grants,
- permission to conduct and plan research on laboratory animals,
- permission to supervise the persons taking care of animals.

The hired person will be obliged to (among others):

- conduct research in the field of animal psychology, publish works in international scientific journals, obtain and conduct grants,
- teach courses in Polish and English (in case of candidates from abroad, at first only in English, but later also in Polish).

We offer:

- employment at the best Faculty of Psychology in Poland (A+ category, accreditation with distinction from PKA, winner of the Perspektywy ranking a number of times) from October 2020,
- work in a dynamic scientific environment,
- support in obtaining and conducting grants as well as in developing teaching skills.

1. Application letter informing that the candidate is ready to participate in the recruitment procedure,

- 2. A filled in form for candidates for employees at the Faculty of Psychology UW (available in the announcement about this job offer on the website <u>www.psych.uw.edu.pl</u>, section "oferty i zamówienia"),
- 3. A copy of the PhD diploma,
- 4. Documents confirming research experience in the field of animal psychology (eg. a list of obtained grants, a statement on employment within a grant etc.),
- 5. Documents confirming teaching experience in the field of animal psychology (eg. course evaluations),
- 6. Documents confirming international experience (eg. stay/internship at a foreign university, cooperation with foreign scientists),
- 7. Documents confirming permissions linked to research and taking care of animals if available,
- 8. CV,
- 9. Research and teaching plans at the Faculty of Psychology UW for the future in case of employment, taking into account research and teaching currently conducted at the Faculty,
- 10. 2 recommendation letters together with contact details to authors (at least one needs to be written by a person from outside of the Faculty of Psychology, University of Warsaw),
- 11. Forms available on the website of the Office of Human Resources (<u>http://bsp.adm.uw.edu.pl/bsp/druki-i-formularze/</u> For the person applying for employment)
 - a. Personal questionnaire for the person applying for employment,
 - b. Clause on personal data processing (please add your consent for processing your personal data in your application letter),
 - c. Statement on primary place of employment.
- 12. A statement confirming that the candidate read and approves the principles of contests for positions of academic teachers (available on the website of the Faculty of Psychology), the statement form is attached to this call.

Till 5 June 2020 candidates will be informed about being invited (or not) to the next stage of recruitment (qualification interviews). Interviews will take place from 8 till 16 June 2020. Candidates will receive information about the result of recruitment procedures till 3 July 2020. Candidates will be informed both about the invitation to the interview and about the result by email (to the address they included in the application documents). The Faculty of Psychology does not reimburse the cost of the trip/hotel.

The competition of applications is the first stage of the procedure of recruitment for positions of academic teachers set out in the Statute, and its positive result provides a basis for further activities.
