Dean of the Faculty of Psychology, University of Warsaw, invites applications for a position of

senior assistant lecturer

(full teaching position)

We are searching for a candidate who likes teaching, being in contact with students and who at the same time has psychotherapeutic knowledge and experience.

Candidates need to have:

- PhD in psychology or in a related field,
- completed 4-year long psychotherapeutic training in one of acknowledged psychotherapy schools,
- work experience as a psychotherapist,
- experience and achievements in didactic work in the field of psychotherapy at a higher education institution (eg. very good course evaluations, authorship of coursebooks, prizes for didactic work etc.),
- fulfilled requirements listed in the par. 113 of the national higher education and science act, dated 20 July 2018 (Dz. U. from 2021, poz. 478 with amendments).

Additionally, a good candidate will have:

• documented experience in organizing didactic processes and/or enhancing teaching quality within higher education.

The hired person will be obliged to (among others):

- teach courses in psychotherapy and general psychology,
- gaining knowledge on teaching quality (this pertains to both teaching and organization of teaching),
- be involved in faculty organizational matters.

We offer:

- employment at the best Faculty of Psychology in Poland (A+ category, accreditation from Polish Accredication Committee, winner of the Perspektywy ranking) from the summer semester 2021/22,
- working in a dynamic scientific environment,
- support in developing teaching skills.

- 4. Official documents confirming completion of a 4-year long psychotherapeutic training in one of acknowledged psychotherapy schools,
- 5. Official documents confirming work experience as a psychotherapist,
- 6. Official documents confirming experience and achievements in didactic work in the field of psychotherapy at a higher education institution (eg. very good course evaluations, authorship of coursebooks, prizes for didactic work etc.),
- 7. Official documents confirming experience in organizing didactic processes and/or enhancing teaching quality within higher education if available,
- 8. Official documents confirming other experience that could be valuable for the selection committee (eg. about other organizational activities, promotion activities)
- 9. CV,
- 10. Teaching plans at the Faculty of Psychology in case of employment,
- 11. 1 recommendation letter together with contact details to the recommending person,
- Forms available on the website of the Office of Human Resources (<u>https://bsp.adm.uw.edu.pl/bsp-druki-do-pobrania/</u> – druki do pobrania – dla kandydata do pracy)
 - a. Personal questionnaire for the person applying for employment,
 - b. Clause on personal data processing (please add your consent for processing your personal data in your application letter),
 - c. Statement on primary place of employment,
- 13. A statement confirming that the candidate read and approves of the principles of contests for positions of academic teachers (available on the website of the Faculty of Psychology), the statement form is attached to this call.

Till the 30th of November 2021 candidates will be informed about being invited (or not) to the next stage of recruitment - qualification interviews. Additionally, invited candidates may be asked to give a (maximum) 1-hour lecture on a topic chosen by the candidate from the field related to this competition of applications. The lecture will be open to all members of the community of the Faculty of Psychology. The exact date of the interview will be discussed by email. Interviews (and possibly lectures) will take place from 6 till 10 December 2021. Candidates will receive information about the result of recruitment procedures till 26 January 2022. Candidates will be informed both about the invitation to the interview and about the result by email (to the address they included in the application documents). The Faculty of Psychology UW does not reimburse hotel/trip costs.

The competition of applications is the first stage of the procedure of recruitment for positions of academic teachers set out in the Statute, and its positive result provides a basis for further activities.
